

Session Prep

A few helpful tips for your Fairy Minis

- Enter Oxley Creek from Sherwood Rd and park at the roundabout near the big red barn
- There are toilets on site but they're drop toilets and to be honest with you, they're always gross
- When you arrive follow the path down the trail to the big tree. This is where I will be (provided no one beats us to the spot first)
- Please wait until just before your session time to change children into their outfits and bring a change of clothes, just in case.
- If there are babies and toddlers, I'd recommend where possible giving them the opportunity for an adequate nap before the session (not always easy I know!)
- Allow time to feed babies prior to the session.
- Please note that as these sessions are back to back, I will be unable to provide extra time, so it is important to not miss your start.
- Please be prepared to step in the photo if required. These sessions are designed to be whimsical and playful, however sometimes kids take a little bit to warm up and sometimes all it takes is mum or dad.
- There will be 4 sets of wings available (including one baby size), magic wands, streamer ribbons, bubbles and a tea party set up
- The most important thing is to make sure your kids are dressed warmly. This time of year can get cold quite quickly at Oxley Creek and warm kids are happy kids. Please see styling inspo on the next pages.

Styling Prep

Recommended:

- I recommend creating a cohesive, complimentary vibe rather than matching outfits.
- Colours that I'd recommend for these sessions would be neutrals like cream, beige and brown tones or muted pinks, light purples, soft blues and sage greens.
- The fairy wings available will be posted on the next page if you'd like to plan your outfits to coordinate. They are all different, which I know isn't always ideal when you have multiple kids, but as their will likely be a variety of ages and number of children, I felt it made more sense for them to all be a little different.
- Textures that photograph well include linen, knits and lace.

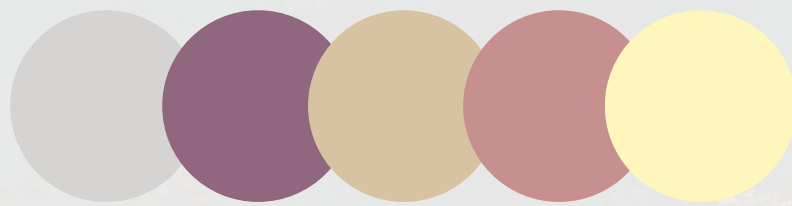
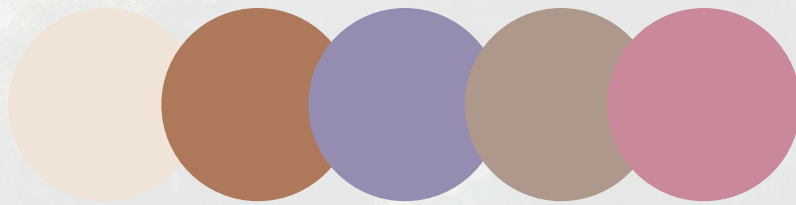
What to avoid:
